- Primer on Innovation Development: Learn the foundational steps to transform ideas into actionable projects.






MODULE 4: CRAFTING IDEAS INTO PROTOTYPES

- Empathy: Research and interview to understand perspectives.
- **Define:** Clearly state the problem for focus.
- Brainstorming: Generate creative solutions.
- Prototyping: Build quick models to test ideas.
- Work Time: Refine and prepare prototypes.
- Feedback: Gather peer and mentor insights.
- Impact Gaps: Identify key areas for impact.
- Social Change Models: Explore growth frameworks.
- End States: Define long-term goals.

MODULE 5: FEEDBACK & CELEBRATION OF LEARNING

- How to Pitch: Learn how to craft a compelling narrative around your project and present it with confidence.
- Work Time: Finalize your pitch and polish your presentation with mentor guidance.
- Pitch Presentations: Present your ideas to a panel of experts, peers, and mentors, receiving actionable feedback.
- Closing Celebration: Reflect on your journey, celebrate your achievements, and connect with your cohort in a meaningful way.
